# **Closer to Buying Land**

We are closer to buying land but still need to raise another \$15,000 to \$20,000. Recently, we have looked at several pieces of land in the area that we feel God calling us to. It is a community not too far outside of Kampala. We have about \$20,000 already saved to use towards the purchase of land. However, land is very expensive in Uganda and we would like to purchase around 5-8 acres. In the community that we are looking at, land is around \$4,000 to \$6,000 an acre. Believe me when I say that this land is VERY cheap compared to other areas of Uganda. Please consider making a donation towards the purchase of land to be able to build a larger Children's Home and help many more hurting children.

#### Resettlement and How It Will Affect Your Sponsorship

After the last newsletter was sent out, we had several people ask questions about how the resettlement process will affect their child sponsorship. It is true that some of the children that have family members will be resettled with them. However, we will still have guardianship over the children so we will act as social workers that will make the decisions with the family members in the child's best interest. We will be doing resettlement very gradually as it is a new process, not only for us, but for the Ugandan government as well. We are doing trainings with several Christian ministries such as Samaritan's Purse that have been doing resettlement for years in other countries. Some African countries have had such a success rate with resettlement that they have very few orphanages.

It will be a long process but we are already seeing positive results with the families and children that we are working with. All of the children are very excited to meet their family members and to visit them. After all, God really intended children to be in families and not in orphanages or childcare institutions. Orphanages were always meant to be a temporary solution and then the long-term solution was to find families (either biological or foster) to take care of the child as their own.

We will always be apart of the children's lives, as we will maintain guardianship. Once the child is resettled, we are planning to check on them monthly and still support the families financially through our child sponsorship program. We will assist the family in making decisions such as where the child will go to school. We are also hoping to be able to hold school holiday camps for the kids so that we can have more time with them to nurture them spiritually.

This is a process and new journey for us as a ministry so we do not have all the answers yet as how it will change the ministry and Uganda in the long run. If you have any questions, please feel free to email us. Keep us in your prayers!
