We are overjoyed that after many years of praying we have been able to purchase land in a community that we feel God is calling us to move to and serve. As you can imagine, this is a huge undertaking but we have BIG faith that God will provide. We have already seen Him provide in many ways.

Rafiki is currently raising funds to build a Children's Home on our newly purchased land. Our hope is to have a transitional children's home, smaller long-term foster care family homes, staff housing, nursery and primary schools to serve the community, health clinic, and multipurpose building to be used for a church and discipleship. The first building to be built will be our transitional Children's Home that will house the current children that we care for. This will allow us to move from our current location that we rent. The money that we will save on renting will go a long way to help us with future building. Our goal is to be moving onto the land by June of 2017. This gives us 18 months to raise \$100,000 and build the first home. We know that this is a large goal but we also know that we serve a GREAT, BIG God that can do anything.

If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully." (Romans 12:6-8)
- CONNECT the ministry with local churches, rotary clubs, schools, businesses, etc. Connect us with your friends

- SPEAK UP and tell their story. What a simple way of obeying God's instruction to us about the poor...simply tell
 their story. Proverbs 31:8-9 says "Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are
 destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy."
