**Christmas Reunion – Children That Have Been Resettled with Families Came to Visit for a Few Days**



## Happy New Year! Thank You!

As each year comes to an end, I always find myself pondering and reflecting on what has happened and what is to come. The importance of your partnership is evident in every child that we have rescued, and in each child in our program that is healthy, learning, and thriving. We are humbled and overwhelmingly grateful for your faithful giving and for your prayers for these kids and our work. Over the last year we were able to accomplish so many incredible things because of your involvement.

- 7 abandoned children were rescued in partnership with the police family and child protection unit and provided a safe and loving home at the Rafiki Children's Home.
- 3 of our families were given income generating projects through our partnership with Samaritan's Purse.
- 18 children were able to attend school and promoted to the next grade level.

- 17 children were reunited with their families and given resettlement kits. Rafiki continues to work with each child and family, pays for their school fees, and helps with other things as needed.
- 5 children were rescued from child trafficking.
- 2 new employees, a social worker and a child care worker, were hired to help with new responsibilities that the ministry has taken on with the Ugandan Government to resettle children.
- 6 acres of land was purchased. A two-bedroom home for land caretakers was finished. 5 acres was fenced and a rain tank was installed.
- Rafiki continues to provide safety, and fosters healing and restoration in 29 children's lives.
- Rafiki continues to work closely with the Government's network and is considered one of the top 20 Children's Home in Uganda (where there are currently over 500 orphanages).

## Commit This New Year to Sponsor a Child!

This year we have seen a lot of growth and with that growth comes more responsibility. Without financial giving, we cannot continue in 2016 to continue to grow our programs to care for more children. We have two main areas where your giving is needed and will bring lasting impact to hurting children in Uganda.

### Child Sponsorship



Child Sponsorship is the core of our programs. We currently care for 29 children. This year we would like to be able to receive more children from the police that are in need of a home. Children are abandoned every day at our local police station. Frequently, we have to say "NO". Our goal is to never have to say "NO" to a child in need of emergency care.

**Ivan** is one of those children that we were able to help that past year. Sadly his younger sister, Vanessa, died shortly after being received from the police into our Children's Home because of severe malnourishment. Ivan is now growing and thriving. Ivan has NO sponsors at this time so to continue to be able to support him we need sponsors. It takes roughly **10** monthly supporters, each at \$35/month, to take care of **ONE** child's needs.

## Building Campaign

We now have 6 acres of land that has been purchased and fenced. This land is ready to be developed into the permanent home for the Rafiki Children's Home and smaller family foster homes for children needing long-term care. - Praise God for the children under our care who carry their Christian faith to their families and serve as a witness to them during family visits and when they are resettled. Pray that God gives them boldness in sharing their faith.
- Praise God for all He has done in 2015 and for all He plans to do through Rafiki in 2016 and the years to come.

## Ways YOU can support the ministry –

- **PRAY** for the ministry and orphans in Uganda. “Brothers and sisters, pray for us.” (1 Thessalonians 5:25)
- **GIVE** financially. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 8:3-4 says, “For I testify that they gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability. Entirely on their own, they urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing in this service to the Lord's people.”

- **SERVE** on the mission field and come to Uganda. We are in desperate need of teachers, childcare workers, nurses, etc. We can use anyone. “We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.” (Romans 12:6-8)

- **SPEAK UP** and tell their story. What a simple way of obeying God’s instruction to us about the poor...simply tell their story. Proverbs 31:8-9 says “Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy.”
