This past week, this little one came to join the Rafiki family. Little Janat was found along side the road near old Kampala police station. Her mentally ill mother who is believed to be a prostitute had abandoned her there. The police traced the mother and found her. The mother did not know her own name or where she came from and it was obvious that she was not capable of caring for her daughter. Janat's father could not be traced so the police contacted Rafiki Children's Home. Janat's mother was admitted to a psychiatric hospital. Little Janat is assumed to be about one and half year old. She is not yet walking, but is crawling and standing. Janat has the most beautiful smile and twinkle in her eyes. She has a very sweet spirit. When she was first given a doll she gave the doll many kisses. She got along with the children right from the beginning, playing and laughing with them. Please be praying for sweet Janat. She is a pure joy!


# Helping Ugandan Families – Shop with a Purpose
