- > Pray for the people in Uganda to hear about Jesus this Christmas! Pray for the Rafiki Team to have more opportunities to share the love of God to our neighbors at the Children's Home and at the Rafiki Land.
- Pray for our newest child, Reagan. He is 9 months old and is very malnourished. We will include more information about him in the next newsletter. Pray for God to give us monthly partners to help with caring for Reagan's needs.
- Pray for the people of Uganda. Pray for those who are so destitute that they must abandon their families in hopes that their children will be "taken in" and survive. Pray for the Ugandan government as they seek ways to protect children and help the abandoned and orphaned children of Uganda.
