Joseph's grandmother is diabetic and has not been feeling well for sometime now. We do not get to visit Mama Amooti as much as we would like as she lives an entire day drive away from us. Please pray with us for Mama Amooti's health and for her to feel better! She has always been a very active woman and was out digging in her garden when Joseph arrived. While Joseph visited family, he also visited some important sites from his childhood.
