Sponsor a Child in 2017

Rafiki Africa Ministries provides a loving, Christian home for children that have been abused and abandoned. It allows us to say "yes" to one more child. This past week has been a difficult one for me (Sara, Founder and Director) as we received a phone call from a policewoman that we work with in the community. She had a 10-month-old little boy that had been abandoned and was in need of emergency care. We hated it when we had to say, "no". Joseph and I prayed about taking this little boy in and just knew that we could not care for another baby without more child sponsors. We had just taken in Baby Reagan who was extremely malnourished and only 9 months old. We are at the limit of our budget and space in our current house. It



broke my heart when we couldn't rescue this boy. I am sure that this baby boy ended up at another children's home but many in Uganda are not operating legally and exploit the children. We are one of the few Children's Homes recognized by the government of Uganda to care for abandoned and abused children. This has encouraged us to know that we are doing the right thing but also given us a HUGE responsibility. Every time we know that when we are unable to receive a hurting child, we know there is a possibility that they will be going somewhere else where they will continue to be abused and go hungry...sometimes even fearing for their life. We are so thankful when God provides the way for us to help as many as possible.

In the past year, we have rescued 11 children by working with the Ugandan Police Child and Family Protection Units of several police stations in and around Kampala. We have reunited 8 of these children with their families. As much as possible, we continue to help these children once they have been resettled in their families

As we continue to grow as a ministry, please know that partnerships with our supporters are vital to the success of the ministry. Your support is not something that we take lightly and is very much appreciated by everyone involved in the ministry. We ask that if you are not currently sponsoring a child through giving monthly (\$35/month) then please prayerfully consider child sponsorship. Introducing Baby Reagan

Reagan is the newest child at Rafiki Children's Home. He is around 9 months old. We do not know his exact birth date because he was abandoned on the train tracks in Kampala. He is malnourished and small for his age. He is not crawling yet but we pray that with love and good nutrition he will grow strong. We are in need of monthly financial sponsors to stand with us to cover Reagan's needs including baby formula with extra protein. Formula in Uganda is very expensive (approximately 3 times as much as you would pay in the United States). We spend roughly \$300/month on formula for only 2 babies.
