Moving Day!



The day finally came to pack our bags and move to the new rental property for the Children's Home. The plan is that this will be our home until we can move to our forever home on our land in Kakiri Village. We are praying that we will be able to build a large Children's Home, multi-purpose building, and school within the next 3-5 years. We will be so excited for the day that we are rent-free. We have begun fundraising so that we can build!! Please let us know if you are interested in learning more about the vision for the ministry land and how Rafiki Africa Ministries is serving the community.

The Rafiki staff spent a week getting the new home ready for the children to move. The house needed some repairs and maintenance before it was time to move in. The landlord painted the entire house inside and out, so the house looks different from the last newsletter. Some of our artistic staff members painted murals in each of the rooms. We wanted the new home to be a surprise for the kids so the staff got everything ready before the kids spent their first night. We moved everything in only 2 days...well, everything except for the kid's mattresses so that they had something to sleep on. ☺



Ways YOU can pray for us this month –

- Praise God for His provision of finances to move to a larger rental property to serve as the Rafiki Children’s Home.
- Praise God that everything went smoothly with the big move to the new home.
- Pray for our newest children – Andrew, Hope, and Jacob. Pray for God to give us monthly partners to help with caring for their needs.
- Pray for Sara’s future trip to the US in October. Pray that God will link the ministry to more individual and church partnerships.
- Pray for the people of Uganda. Pray for those who are so destitute that they must abandon their families in hopes that their children will be “taken in” and survive. Pray for the Ugandan government as they seek ways to protect children and help the abandoned and orphaned children of Uganda. Pray for Children’s Homes, like Rafiki, who are struggling to have the finances and means to support as many children as possible.
- Pray that God will provide the funding needed to move to our new land. Currently, we need \$250,000 to complete the first part of our building phase so that we can move the Children’s Home permanently to our land in Kakiri. This will enable us to serve more children and families in the community.
